- 4 When the earth quakes, with all living on it, it is I who hold its support-pillars firm.” (Selah)**
- 5 To the boastful I say, “Do not boast!” and to the wicked, “Don’t flaunt your strength!**
- 6 Don’t flaunt your strength so proudly; don’t speak arrogantly, with your nose in the air!**
- 7 For you will be not be raised to power by those in the east, the west or the desert;**
