Yom Teruah / Rosh HaShannah

Erev Yom Teruah, Monday, Sept 6, 6:00pm

We will eat the festival meal together first, and have our shofar service following the meal.

Yom Teruah Morning Service, Tuesday, Sept 7, 11:30am

Tuesday, Sept 7, is a Sabbath

We will eat lunch together following the service, and then have our Tashlich service (at Titlow Beach) following lunch (around 2:30pm)

Yom Kippur

Erev Yom Kippur, Kol Nidre Service, Wed, Sept 15, 7:30pm

Yom Kippur Service, Thursday, Sept 16, 4:00pm

Thursday, September 16, is a Sabbath

We will have the afternoon service at 4:00pm, concluding with the reading of Jonah.

We will have a concluding service of worship and sharing beginning at 6:00 pm. Following sunset (which is at 7:20pm), we will break the fast together. (Bring food for our corporate meal as we break the fast.)

Sukkot

Erev Sukkot, Monday, Sept 20, 6:00pm

We will eat the festival meal together at 6:00pm and spend the rest of the evening rejoicing in the Sukkah (singing, reading Qohelet.)

Tuesday, Sept 21, is a Sabbath (no morning service at the Shul; Celebrate as we visit together in our Sukkot.)

Erev Shemini Atzeret, (8th Day), Monday, Sept 27, 6:00pm

We will eat the festival meal at 6:00pm, and conclude the Sukkot Festival together.

We will also celebrate Simchat Torah together after dinner, unrolling the scrolls as per our custom.

Tuesday, Sept 28, is a Sabbath (no morning service at the Shul)
