- 16 The eyes of ADONAI watch over the righteous, and His ears are open to their cry.**
- 17 But the face of ADONAI opposes those who do evil, to cut off all memory of them from the earth.**
- 18 They cried out, and ADONAI heard, and He saved them from all their troubles.**
- 19 ADONAI is near those with broken hearts; He saves those whose spirit is crushed.**
- 20 The righteous person suffers many evils, but ADONAI rescues him out of them all.**
- 21 He protects all his bones; not one of them gets broken.**
- 22 Evil will kill the wicked, and those who hate the righteous will be condemned.**
- 23 But ADONAI redeems His servants; no one who takes refuge in Him will be condemned.**
