Num 2:14 - 3:13

Isaiah 8:18 - 22

John 6:26 - 51

Num. 2:9 The total of the numbered men of the camp of Judah: 186,400, by their armies. They shall set out first.

Num. 2:16 The total of the numbered men of the camp of Reuben: 151,450 by their armies. And they shall set out second.

Num. 2:24 The total of the numbered men of the camp of Ephraim: 108,100, by their armies. And they shall set out third.

Num. 2:31 The total of the numbered men of the camp of Dan was 157,600. They shall set out last by their standards.”

Num. 1:47-48 The Levites, however, were not numbered among them by their fathers’ tribe. ⁴⁸ For the LORD had spoken to Moses, saying,

Num. 1:53 But the Levites shall camp around the tabernacle of the testimony, so that there will be no wrath on the congregation of the sons of Israel. So the Levites shall keep charge of the tabernacle of the testimony.”

Num. 1:2-3 “Take a census of all the congregation of the sons of Israel, by their families, by their fathers’ households, according to the number of names, every male, head by head ³ from twenty years old and upward, whoever is able to go out to war in Israel, you and Aaron shall number them by their armies.

Num. 3:10 So you shall appoint Aaron and his sons that they may keep their priesthood, but the layman who comes near shall be put to death.”

Psa. 91:4 He will cover you with His pinions, and under His wings you may seek refuge; His faithfulness is a shield and bulwark.

Deut. 32:9-12 For the LORD’S portion is His people; Jacob is the allotment of His inheritance.

¹⁰ He found him in a desert land, and in the howling waste of a wilderness;
He encircled him, He cared for him, He guarded him as the pupil of His eye.

¹¹ Like an eagle that stirs up its nest, that hovers over its young,
He spread His wings and caught them, He carried them on His pinions.

¹² The LORD alone guided him, and there was no foreign god with him.

Mal. 4:1-3 “For behold, the day is coming, burning like a furnace; and all the arrogant and every evildoer will be chaff; and the day that is coming will set them ablaze,” says the LORD of hosts, “so that it will leave them neither root nor branch.” ² “But for you who fear My name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings; and you will go forth and skip about like

calves from the stall. ³ You will tread down the wicked, for they will be ashes under the soles of your feet on the day which I am preparing,” says the LORD of hosts.

Eph. 6:10-11 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might. ¹¹ Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil.

Eph. 6:14-17 Stand firm therefore, HAVING GIRDED YOUR LOINS WITH TRUTH, and HAVING PUT ON THE BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS, ¹⁵ and having shod YOUR FEET WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE; ¹⁶ in addition to all, taking up the shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. ¹⁷ And take THE HELMET OF SALVATION, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

Psa. 15:1-4 O LORD, who may abide in Your tent? Who may dwell on Your holy hill?

² He who walks with integrity, and works righteousness, and speaks truth in his heart.

³ He does not slander with his tongue, nor does evil to his neighbor,
Nor takes up a reproach against his friend;

⁴ In whose eyes a reprobate is despised, but who honors those who fear the LORD;
He swears to his own hurt and does not change;

1John 3:6-8 No one who abides in Him sins; no one who sins has seen Him or knows Him. ⁷ Little children, make sure no one deceives you; the one who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is righteous; ⁸ the one who practices sin is of the devil; for the devil has sinned from the beginning. The Son of God appeared for this purpose, to destroy the works of the devil.

Mark 15:42 When evening had already come, because it was the preparation day, that is, the day before the Sabbath,

Psa. 91:1-2 He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High
Will abide in the shadow of the Almighty.

² I will say to the LORD, “My refuge and my fortress,
My God, in whom I trust!”

Psa. 91:9 For you have made the LORD, my refuge, even the Most High, your dwelling place.

Rom. 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

Psa. 149:5-6 Let the godly ones exult in glory; Let them sing for joy on their beds.
